JOHN MILTON SHIELD

John Milton was one of Normandy's longest serving members, his career spanning the years either side of the 2nd World War, he captained the 1st XI from 1948 to 1956 before finally retiring in 1960. He was elected Club President in 1963, a post he held until his death in 1979 and he is one of only two Club members to be commemorated with a stone plaque on the pavilion entrance. Whilst his playing statistics are unremarkable, he was highly regarded as one of the greatest motivators in the club's history and his vision and the standards he set continue to be the backbone of the Club's constitution. After John's death a shield was presented in his memory to award to the outstanding player of the year. This is the most prestigious annual award that the Club presents and players in all senior teams are eligible for the award which is decided by the Cricket Committee each year.

DH ROBERTS CUP

(Colt of the year)

Doug Roberts was the Club's longest serving member, having joined Normandy in 1922 and remained a member to his death at the age of 102 in 2002 – a period of 80 years. He was 1st team captain either side of the Second World War, Chairman from 1946 to 1967, groundman until 1980 (retiring reluctantly at the ripe age of 80) and Club President from 1980 to his death. Doug presented a cup to the Colts section so that they too could reward the outstanding player in the Youth section with a trophy each year.
